YAHUKIMO- The Task Forces of the Infantry Battalion 6 Marines, part of the Indonesian Armed Forces Operational Command (KOOPS TNI) in Papua, is currently carrying out mobile security at the border of Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, especially in the Yahukimo Regency area, Papua Pegunungan Province. On Friday, 5 July 2024, in the context of regional security duties, the Marines Task Forces carried out a patrol by visiting and greeting residents in the Massi Village, Dekai District.

The Commander of the Marines Task Forces, Lieutenant Colonel Rismanto Manurung, has left a message to the Soldiers who will carry out patrol duties on that Friday, that every Soldier should use their assignment for positive things, not just carrying out duties on a daily basis.
